COVID-19:

As you are aware, all schools in Hawaii were required to close just before the end of last school year due to the COVID-19 virus. Our Governor has issued guidelines for all Hawaii schools in order for them to re-open for on-campus learning in August of 2020. Please be assured that our CLA Administration takes the health and safety of our students, staff, and CLA Ohana very seriously and has developed our in-house COVID-19 Protocols that we have begun to implement in order to be in alignment with our Governor's orders. We will open for on-campus learning on August 12, 2020. If at any time schools are required to close we will follow our COVID-19 Protocols. Please read the attached Addendum to the handbook so that you are aware of our plan to keep our students current with their academics during any school closures. We have a good plan to keep our school family healthy, and a plan for Distance Learning in case we need it. Praise God.

Financials:

Please make sure that you have paid your Registration Fee (100.00), Comprehensive Fee (500.00), and one month security deposit (May Tuition Deposit) before the first day of school. **The one month security deposit, called our May Tuition Deposit, is required from every family before school begins. This one month tuition deposit is held on the student's account and applied to their last month of school (May). Each family will be billed for this in July.*Invoice coming soon.

Tuition for August is due by the first day of school. Each family will be billed for this Aug. 1st.

Payments to CLA are made online, using our secure Quickbooks Intuit web portal. Monthly invoices will be emailed to you with a "PAY NOW" button embedded. You may pay directly out of your checking account with no additional fees. To enable the credit card option please call Mrs. Balanay (966-8446). There is a 3.5% processing fee for this option.

<u>3 year old Preschool</u>: Teacher will purchase supplies for the year. At the beginning of the school year, each family will need to reimburse the teacher directly \$25.00 for the school supplies.

Parents should also bring 1 sleeping mat, 1 small blanket, 1 nap pillow, 1 backpack (optional), 1 change of clothes, and 1 pair of slippers.

<u>4 year old Preschool:</u> 1 pkg snack size zip lock bags, plastic pencil box, box 24 crayons, scissors, 10 classic color marker pens, Crayola watercolors, 3 bottles of glue, 2 inch binder with clear front pocket, 75 sheet protectors, 1 set of 5 tabs for binders, 1 plastic covered sleeping mat, 1 change of clothes, 1 pair of slippers.

2020/2021 KINDERGARTEN - 5TH GRADE SUPPLY LIST
