## 2018/2019 PRESCHOOL SUPPLY LIST

**All Preschoolers Need:** 1 set Crayola watercolor paints, 1 pkg. BandAids, 1 pkg. wide markers-Classic colors, 1-2 inch 3 ring binder (with clear plastic sheet or front to slip a picture inside.), 1 pkg. 24. Crayons, 1 pkg. 50 sheet protectors, 3 bottles of white glue, 1 mat for nap time (42x20) 4 fold, 1 regular sized backpack- brought to school daily, 1 small blanket and tiny pillow (must fit in backpack), 1 change of clothes (not uniform) and slippers

**Additional items for 3 year olds:** 3-3 prong folders: red, yellow and orange (no names on folders, please), 2 pack/rolls double sided tape, 1 pkg. hand wipes, Colored card stock, 1 pkg. reward stickers

**Additional items for 4 year olds:** Small pencil box for crayons & scissors, 1 pkg. 5. Tab index pages for binders, 1 plastic 2 pocket folder (for papers to go home), 1 pair scissors

## 2018/2019 KINDERGARTEN – 5<sup>TH</sup> GRADE SUPPLY LIST

**KINDERGARTEN:** 2 pocket folders (FiveStar or 3M vinyl without prong), 12 #2 Mirado/Papermate pencils, 2 Magic Rub erasers, 2 reg. size crayons(24), wide tip markers, Fiscars scissors, 3 bottles **Elmer's** glue, 3 glue sticks, colored pencils, pencil box, paint apron, watercolor paints, 8 x 12 dry erase board, dry erase markers & eraser, small blanket, mat (tri fold or quarter fold), 2 primary journals (tablets), 4 bleach disinfectant wipes, backpack, extra change of clothes including underwear in a ziplock bag, small folding umbrella with rounded points.

**FIRST GRADE:** Teacher will purchase supplies for the year. At the beginning of the school year, each family will need to reimburse the teacher directly \$25.00 for the school supplies. Students will need to have their own backpack, lunch bag, water bottle, and Bible.

**SECOND GRADE:** 5 marble tablets, 1 ruler-in & cm, 24 #2 pencils, 12 colored pencils, 2 magic rub erasers, pencil box, 1 large bottle glue, box of 24 crayons, wide tip markers, Fiscars scissors, 8 x 12 dry erase board with black marker and eraser, 2 3-prong folders, 2 pocket folders, 1 3-ring 1 inch binder, and a Bible.

**THIRD GRADE:** Teacher will purchase supplies for the year. At the beginning of the school year, each family will need to reimburse the teacher directly \$25.00 for the school supplies. Students will need to have their own backpack, lunch bag, and water bottle.
