KINDERGARTEN: 2 pocket folders (Five Star or 3M vinyl without prong), 2 Magic Rub erasers, 2 sets of reg. size crayons(24), wide tip markers, 1 set of colored pencils, pencil box, watercolor paint set, 8 x 12 dry erase board, dry erase markers & eraser, small blanket, vinyl mat (tri fold), 1 primary journal(tablet), 2 bottles Elmer’s glue, 4 glue sticks, 4 bleach disinfectant wipes, 2-8oz bottles or 1-64oz Bottle Hand Sanitizer, backpack, paint apron or large t-shirt, extra change of clothes including underwear in a zip lock bag, small folding umbrella (kid’s size) with rounded points.
